The European Directive 2002/95/CE and the Council of 27 January 2003, applicable as from 1 July 2006, limits the use of Lead, Mercury, Hexavalent Chromium, Cadmium, PolyBrominated Biphenyls (PBB) and PolyBrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE).

The Directive has since been significantly revised and as of 1 January 2013, the edition 2011/65/EU is applicable.
